

Drug Demand Reduction-General

OPERATION OF DRUG DEMAND REDUCTION PROGRAM BELOW WING LEVEL

This instruction establishes requirements for unit or group responsibilities in the Drug Demand Reduction Program.

DRUG DEMAND REDUCTION OFFICER (DDRO) They Shall:

Manage and direct drug demand reduction activities. Develop annual Drug Demand Reduction. (DDR) training plan. Prepare and submit the annual Drug Demand Reduction Initiative Program application. Prepare and manage annual DDR financial plan. Conduct annual DDR training at wing encampment(s). Coordinate joint operations with Air Force base DDR Coordinators. Coordinate joint operations with Air Force Reserve base DDR Coordinators. Coordinate joint operations with National Guard DDR Administrator. Submits activity reports. The Drug Demand Reduction Officer should be familiar with CAPP 55 and CAPR 52-16.

Assistant Drug Demand Reduction Officer (Cadet)

Responsible to DDRO for providing a cadet perspective on the needs and issues relating to drug demand reduction. Assists in conducting training activities and plans for unit. Assists in developing initiatives for annual DDRIP based on recommendations from cadets. Represent unit at annual planning meeting for Wing DDR initiative development. Assists DDRO with other duties as required.

DDR Education Activity

Units will conduct the quarterly DDR education activity as outlined in CAP pamphlet 55, Missouri Wing pamphlet operating instructions 55-2, or other drug education materials available. The activity will address drug-related issues, which may affect Civil Air Patrol cadets.

DDR Squadron Award

Missouri Wing will award an annual DDR squadron of the year. This unit will receive a plaque and additional DDR resources as chosen by the Drug Demand Reduction Administrator. Selection for this award will be based on quality of activities conducted, timeliness of reports submitted, participation in DDRIP and coordination with outside agencies as described in CAP pamphlet 55.
