**COMMUNICATIONS**

CAPR 100-1, Volume 1 dated 1 August 1996 is supplemented as follows:

5-1. Missouri Wing form 76a, Application for Radio Operator's Authorization will be completed and sent to MO Wing to apply for a ROA.


6-1. Missouri Wing form 96, Radio Station Application and Authorization, will be completed and sent to MO Wing when needed.

7-1. All communicators directly operating communications equipment for periods of four hours or longer are mandated to take down time of not less than one hour for each four hour shift of operations. This is to ensure that stress/pressure levels do not develop which could inadvertently interfere with proper operation of the equipment and ability of the operator to pass traffic as formatted.

7-15b. Tactical call signs for all Missouri Wing staff positions will change with staffing. Those members receiving a staff call sign will maintain their former call sign. In accordance with this all personnel from the Missouri Wing that hold staff positions at the region or national level will have their respective Missouri Wing call sign deactivated while serving at those levels.
