## AVIATION DAY AT THE CAPITOL

## BACKGROUND

Cadets and Senior Members of the Missouri Wing - Civil Air Patrol visits the State Capitol on Aviation Day to increase awareness with our partner state Government and Legislators.

## CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS

CAP will have a display set up in the 3rd floor rotunda. Members will also visit legislators and be able to go up to the top of the Capitol dome.

## PREREQUISITES

Before 14 April 2015, senior members must have completed Level I and Cadets should have their Curry Achievement, and be current Safety Education Requirements outlined in CAPR 62-1 paragraph 4.

## EXPECTATIONS

Members visit legislators and participate in tours.

**Legislators love to talk with the cadets.** If you don't know who your state legislators are, go to <http://www.house.mo.gov>. Enter your zip +4 on the lower left side and you will be able to find out who your legislators are. Email them if you would like an appointment with them. Keep in mind; they are typically in session from 1000-1200 and 1330-1400.

## PARKING

Parking near the capitol will be at a premium. There are several lots within walking distance of the Capitol building. If you park in the circle drive around the Capitol building, there is a 2 hour limit. However, if you go over the 2 hour limit, it is a \$10 parking fine payable by mail. They usually don't ticket CAP vans.

## UNIFORM WEAR

All uniform combinations MUST be compliant IAW CAPM 39-1. USAF Blue shirt combination for Cadets and Senior Members. Senior Members may also wear the corporate white aviator or polo combinations. Members that do not have these uniforms must dress in business casual (Polo or dress shirt with dress slacks or kakis). No jeans or T-Shirts.

## FUNDING/REIMBURSEMENT

Reimbursement for fuel or per diem must be approved by your unit finance committee.

## LUNCH

There will be lunch served free of charge in the Rotunda. Also, Jefferson Landing State Historic Site grounds and the Carnahan Memorial Garden at the intersection of Jefferson Street and Capital Avenue can be used for brown bag lunches. Vending machines are available in the Capitol basement. The cafeteria in the Capitol (573-634-2411) is open to the public but reservations are preferred for large groups. Fast food restaurants and other restaurants are located on Missouri Boulevard, and it is advisable to call ahead to the restaurant of your choice.

## EXPLORING YOUR CAPITAL CITY

If your unit plans to meet with your Legislator before the 1000 session, you might be finished by noon. There are several sites to see in Jefferson City of historical significance. See attached.

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Cadets must have a [CAPF 32](#) *Cadet Activity Permission Slip* and ALL Members must carry a [CAPF 161](#) *Emergency Information Form*.

## **Things to see in Jefferson City**

**State Capitol and Missouri State Museum**—Free guided tours of the Capitol are offered year round. Reservations are required for groups of 10 or more. From June through February, scheduled group tours are every half hour beginning at 9 a.m. (excluding the noon hour) with the last tour beginning at 4 p.m. From March through May, scheduled group tours begin at the top of the hour, 20 minutes past the hour and 40 minutes past the hour (excluding the noon hour). Reservations may be made online at [www.mocapitoltours.com](http://www.mocapitoltours.com). Visitors may also learn about Missouri's cultural and natural history in the Missouri State Museum exhibit galleries. For questions, please call the Missouri State Museum at 573-751-2854.

**Jefferson Landing State Historic Site** is located at the north end of Jefferson Street. This former 19<sup>th</sup> century riverboat landing includes two buildings – the Lohman Building, which is the oldest commercial building still standing in Jefferson City, and the Union Hotel, which houses the Rozier Gallery featuring rotating exhibits. Both buildings are free of charge. They are open March 1 through Labor Day, Tuesday through Saturday, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Reservations can be made online at [www.mocapitoltours.com](http://www.mocapitoltours.com) to view a 20-minute film in the Lohman Building on the history of Jefferson City. For questions, please call the Missouri State Museum at 573-751-2854.

**Missouri Governor's Mansion** is located two blocks east of the Capitol on Capital Avenue. Guided tours are on the hour and the half hour from 10 a.m. to noon and from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays from January through February and mid-May through November. From March 1 through mid-May, tours are every 15 minutes from 9 a.m. to noon and from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. During the month of December, the Mansion only offers candlelight tours. For groups of 10 or more people, reservations are required for tours of the Missouri Governor's Mansion; however, walk-in groups of less than 10 people are also welcome. Reservations can be made online at [www.mocapitoltours.com](http://www.mocapitoltours.com). For questions, please call the Missouri State Museum at 573-751-2854. Tours are free.

**Supreme Court Building** is located on High Street across from the Capitol. Tours are offered to the public on the half-hour from 9 a.m. to noon and from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding public holidays and times when the Court is hearing oral arguments. Reservations are recommended and can be made by contacting the Supreme Court of Missouri at 573-751-4144.

**Cole County Historical Society** is located on Madison Street across from the Missouri Governor's Mansion. The Cole County Historical Society features the inaugural gowns of the former first ladies of Missouri and exhibits on Jefferson City and Cole County history. The museum is open to the public Tuesday through Saturday, 1p.m. until 3 p.m. Arrangements for groups of 15 or more can be made by calling the museum at 573-635-1850. The museum is closed from mid-December to the first Tuesday in February. There is a small entrance fee. Visit [www.colecohistsoc.org/](http://www.colecohistsoc.org/)

**Missouri State Highway Patrol Safety Education Center and Museum** is located at 1510 East Elm. The museum has a comprehensive display on traffic safety, law enforcement, drug abuse and items relating to the history of the Missouri State Highway Patrol. There are exhibits focusing on the services and responsibilities of the Highway Patrol on and off the highways. Open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, except holidays. For groups of more than 10 people, reservations can be made by calling 573-751-3313. Tours are free.

**Runge Nature Center** is located half a mile north of US Hwy. 50 on Hwy 179. The nature center with displays is open Tuesday through Saturday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. (until 8 p.m. on Thursdays). Trails are open daily 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. Reservations for tours can be made by calling 573-526-5544. Tours are free.

**Missouri Veterinary Medical Museum** is located at 2500 County Club Drive. Visitors have the opportunity to learn more about animals and the veterinary profession at this museum. Museum is open 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, and by appointment on Saturday. For more information, call 573-636-8737. Tours are free.

**Museum of Missouri Military History** is located at the Ike Skelton Training Center on Militia Drive off of US Hwy. 50/63. Open to the public Monday-Friday from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Closed all major holidays. For groups of more than 10 people, reservations need to be made at least 10 days in advance by calling 573-638-9603. Tours are free.




